When it comes to topical anti-aging treatments, I consistently recommend vitamins A and C. They help fight free radicals and reverse sun damage, which contribute to many of the aesthetic concerns my patients seek to correct.

A skeptic of what he refers to as “minimally invasive and nonsurgical aesthetic trends that tout themselves as being able to completely reverse the signs of aging,” Dr. Petroff believes that tried-and-trusted procedures, in the hands of an experienced surgeon, offer “longer-lasting rejuvenation benefits.” Not one to recommend surgery unless he feels that it will best resolve a patient’s cosmetic concerns, Dr. Petroff doesn’t believe in cutting any corners. “I’m a proponent of the deep-plane facelift because it repositions the underlying muscles and tissues to yield dramatic results that last over time,” he explains. “My techniques and recommendations are based on how extensive each patient’s symptoms range. I tailor my approach in accordance with their needs.”

LIFT OFF

To comprehensively reverse the effects of jowling, droopiness and skin laxity, **Dr. Petroff** prefers the deep plane facelift for its ability to restore youthful integrity to an aging face.

FORM AND FUNCTION

Seeking to improve beauty and function with every procedure performed, **Dr. Petroff** addresses both internal and external considerations, with the goal of delivering results that go beyond physical appearance.



Given the choice, Dr. Petroff prefers spending a bit more time operating if it means more aesthetic results and fewer complications for the patient. That’s why his facelift of choice for patients requiring comprehensive facial rejuvenation is the traditional deep plane procedure. “It affords maximum benefits and natural outcomes, while avoiding an overly tightened look,” he says. With a specialized focus on nasal surgery, Dr. Petroff favors “an open rhinoplasty technique,” which utilizes a small incision between the nostrils, particularly when he’s correcting tip deformities. “An open rhinoplasty allows for high visibility, helping to yield results I can proudly stand behind,” he says. Driven by the satisfaction his patients express post-surgically when their goals are realized, Dr. Petroff says that limiting his scope to the face and neck has enabled him to hone his skills in a field that “marries artistic expression with surgical application.”
